Without dedicated, innovative women, society would not flourish. Their initiative, determination, work and influence extends across generational borders. The 100th Anniversary Scholarship is to be awarded to two female students from each Stratford Secondary School in their 2021 graduating year.

**Name of Award:** The ‘Leaders Among Us’ CFUW Stratford Award

**Amount of Award:** \$500

### **Selection:**

The recipient will be a female student with an Ontario Secondary School diploma who will be enrolled in a recognized Canadian University, college or apprenticeship immediately following Secondary School.

### **Selection Criteria:**

The student will have made a meaningful contribution to the culture of her school, and local or global communities. She is a leader who shows initiative, ingenuity and motivates others to embrace new challenges and issues. She will be a student who takes thoughtful risks, persists in problem solving, embraces collaboration and works through the critical and creative processes as outlined in the Global Competency Framework.

The winner of this award will be determined by the Principal and Staff of the Secondary School who will provide the name to the Chair of the Awards Committee.

### **Presentation:**

Presentation will be by a representative of CFUW- Stratford Scholarship Committee at the annual Commencement Ceremony.

## CFUW- STRATFORD SCHOLARSHIPS 2021

### 1. Name of Award: The CFUW Merit Award

**Amount of Award: \$400**

**Selection:** The recipient will have shown great improvement but has not necessarily received the highest marks. The award is to be given to a female student who would not normally be given a scholarship. Financial need may be a consideration.

**Selection Criteria:** The recipient will be a female student who has an Ontario Secondary School diploma. She must be enrolled at a recognized post secondary institution or in an apprenticeship immediately following Secondary School.

**Selection Procedure:** The winner of the award will be determined by the Awards Committee of the Secondary School.

**Presentation:** Presentation will be by a representative of the CFUW- Stratford Scholarship Fund Committee at the annual Commencement Ceremony.

### 2. Name of Award: CFUW French Immersion Award

**Amount of Award: \$400.00**

**Selection:** The recipient will be the female student with the highest average in the four (4) FIF courses having completed the 7 or 10 credit immersion program.

**Selection Criteria:** The recipient will be a female student who has an Ontario Secondary School Diploma. She will be enrolled at a recognized Canadian university, or college immediately following Secondary School.

**Selection Procedure:** The winner of this award will be determined by the Head of the French Department who will provide the name to the Chair of the Awards Committee.

**Presentation:** Presentation will be by a representative of the CFUW-Stratford Scholarship Fund Committee at the annual Commencement Ceremony.

### **3. Name of Award: The CFUW Award for The Arts**

**Amount of the Award: \$400.00**

**Selection:** The recipient will be the female student with the highest marks in any two Grade 12 courses from the Ontario Arts Curriculum: Dance, Drama, Media Arts, Visual Arts, Music. At least one of the courses must be taken in the final year of secondary school.

**Selection Criteria:** The recipient will be a female student who has an Ontario Secondary School Diploma. She will be enrolled at a recognized Canadian university, or college immediately following secondary school.

**Selection Procedure:** The winner of this award will be determined by the Head of the Arts Department and given to the Chair of the Awards Committee.

**Presentation:** Presentation will be by a representative of the CFUW-Stratford Scholarship Fund Committee at the annual Commencement Ceremony.

### **4. Name of Award: The CFUW STEM Award - Math and Science**

**Amount of the Award: \$400.00**

**Selection:** The recipient will be the female student with the highest average in three Grade 12 Math and Science courses. The winner must be continuing her post-secondary education in the academic year immediately following the completion of secondary school.

**Selection Criteria:** The recipient will be a female student who has an Ontario Secondary School Diploma. She will be enrolled at a recognized Canadian university.

**Selection Procedure:** The winner of this award will be determined by the Math and Science Department Heads who will provide the name to the Chair of the Awards Committee.

**Presentation:** Presentation will be by a representative of the CFUW-Stratford Scholarship Fund Committee at the annual Commencement Ceremony.

**5. Name of Award: The CFUW STEM Award - Technological Studies**

**Amount of the Award: \$400.00**

**Selection:** The recipient will be the female student with the highest average in **three** courses from the Ontario Technology Curriculum. At least one of the courses must be taken in the final year of secondary school.

**Selection Criteria:** The recipient will be a female student who has an Ontario Secondary School Diploma. She will be enrolled at a recognized Canadian university, college or in an apprenticeship immediately following secondary school.

**Selection Procedure:** The winner of this award will be determined by the Head of the Technological Studies Department.

**Presentation:** Presentation will be by a representative of the CFUW-Stratford Scholarship Fund Committee at the annual Commencement Ceremony.

**6. Name of Award: CFUW Mature Student Award**

**Amount of Award: \$400.00**

**Selection:** This award will be given to a female who has completed a high school equivalency program at the Community College level.

**Selection Criteria:** The female recipient will be a resident of Perth County, has completed the high school equivalency program and is enrolled in a Canadian post secondary institution or apprenticeship.

**Selection Procedure:** Selection will be made by the staff of Conestoga College, in consultation with the CFUW-Stratford Scholarship Fund Committee.

**Presentation:** No presentation parameters are mentioned in the most recent document.
